Buildings, Grounds & Transportation - Committee met with Jeff Songster from U&S Services. ECS is looking at a service contract for the controls on all of our systems (heating, air, boiler, etc.). The most basic contract is \$1,700. Superintendent Miller stated that ECS could try a one-year contract and see how it goes. The contract will enable Randy Wiser to dial in and have a technician remotely handle some of the problems, while at the same time Randy can shadow on his computer (will provide needed training). The committee also spent a bit of time looking at the bond cycle in regards to a future capital project. They also looked at the building condition survey.
