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### **Superintendent's Report:**

- 1. We could not open the MS/HS today because contract tracing was not completed by the DOH. We are down 10 teachers and support staff tomorrow. Maren & Erich will be subbing tomorrow if we open for MS/HS. Superintendent Miller stated that he may have to sub as well. There is a very difficult decision to make regarding going remote tomorrow. We may be able to keep the elementary open. We simply don't have enough subs. Maren, Erich and Superintendent Miller will be meeting after the board meeting this evening to make the decision.
- 2. Budget continue to work with Rick Timbs. Have to replenish reserves. It was a very good meeting we had.
- 3. State Aid Governor holding up transportation aid. Not getting aid for meals, transportation or employees during COVID.
- 4. Estimate it would cost around \$30,000 to get "Hot Spots" for district residents. Trying to figure all of this out is insane.
- 5. Robo Calls Superintendent Miller stated that he knows a lot of his calls have been later in the evening, but he has to wait for info from the Department of Health and they have not been getting back to him until 7 pm or after. He stated that he can make a call earlier, but that would mean going to remote learning and at this point the administrators are trying not to miss an opportunity to have students in the building learning.
- 6. Good New is there are a few workshops coming up regarding State Aid. Also, we are in the process of going through our FEMA Grant.
- 7. Still working with the cable and phone companies. 3 municipalities have said that if we can get high speed internet, we can use their parking lots.
- 8. Construction Project we keep getting our approvals. Superintendent Miller stated that he thinks people will be pleased, especially with the parking lots and lighting. Anticipate getting bids out just before or after Christmas.
- 9. Winter Sports NYSPHSAA released info for "High Risk" winter sports. They stated that they can start practices on January 4<sup>th</sup>. This is contingent on guidance from New York State. Watching Skiing they can begin practice on November 30<sup>th</sup>. We may be the only school in our Section with skiing.
- 10. Closing and Covid in a yellow zone you have to test 20% to keep students and teachers in building and do random testing every week. If we go remote, we still have to test 20% of whoever comes in the building to work.
- 11. After this meeting Maren, Erich and Superintendent Miller will be meeting to discuss options for opening tomorrow. Whether it will be Elementary in person and MS/HS remote or everyone remote. Superintendent Miller stated that the District Administrators are going to do the best for the students. He added that they are in a tough spot.
- 12. Thursday P/T Conferences All Conferences will be remote. Teachers have been given the opportunity to do their conferences from home or stay at school and do them.

- 1. Day 3 of full remote. November 2<sup>nd</sup> was day 1 and yesterday and today were 2 & 3. Started using a tally sheet to track remote engagement for students in grades 7-12. Teachers are reaching out to kids who we have not heard from in the AM.
