Dear ECS Parent:

Unfortunately, our cases of individuals testing positive for COVID 19 at the school has continued to increase. This will also result in the need for more people to be placed on quarantine. In light of this, Ellicottville Central School will remain on an all remote instructional model for all students for the remainder of this week. We are doing this to best ensure everyone's safety and to curb the spread of COVID. This transition to remote instruction includes ECS students attending CTE classes, students in the Big Picture program at ECS, all after school activities, and, until we are able to conduct all contact tracing, sports practices are cancelled. When it is safe to resume practices, coaches will contact athletes.

Meals will be delivered to all District residents on Wednesday and non-resident students may pick up meals between 11 and 1 at the Elementary Entrance. We are working on a registration process for meals after that and we will be in contact.

If you are contacted by a county tracer, please follow their instructions.

More detailed information about the current impact COVID is having on ECS, including numbers, will be posted to the District website and Facebook page.
