I'm writing to let you know that we continue to see new positive cases of COVID 19 at the school. While many of the new cases are affecting younger students, they are also creating a significant shortage of staff.

In light of this, the District will continue to follow an all remote instructional model for all students, including Big Picture students, on Monday, November 22nd and Tuesday, November 23rd, and we will be on Thanksgiving Break for the remainder of the week. We will reopen for in-person instruction on Monday, November 29th.

Given the unique circumstances on how the District is being affected, students in CTE Classes may voluntarily report directly to BOCES on Monday and Tuesday. If a student drives to CTE Classes, they need to report to the BOCES office upon arrival.

We are going to allow sports practices to resume. Coaches will be in contact with athletes.

On Monday and Tuesday, we will continue to provide meals. We will deliver meals to District residents and non-residents may pick-up meals between 11:00 and 1:00 at the Elementary entrance.

All staff should follow the same plans they have been using this week.

If you are contacted by a county tracer, please follow their instructions.
