But the frogs are so quick!

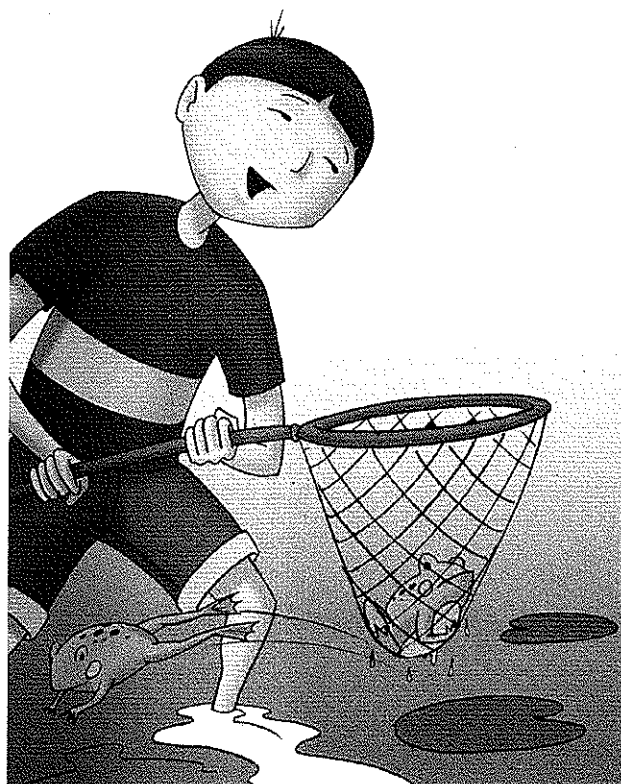
The frogs are so slick!
